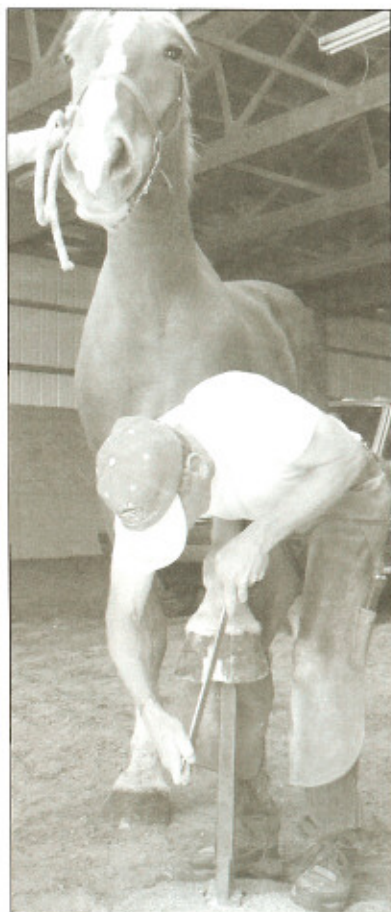

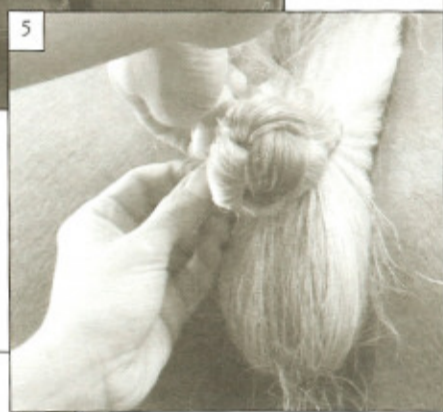
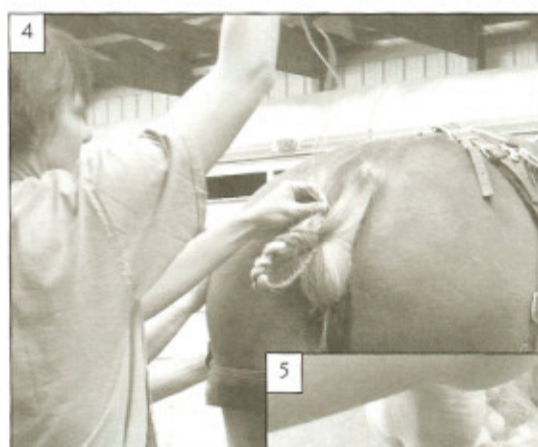


CLIPPING TIPS
